- 1. Will the government introduce a right-to-buy scheme that allows trusts to bring badvalue contracts into public ownership. by legislating for the right to enfranchisement? Will all staff be brought back in house?
- 2. Will the government publish a record of the true comparative costs of PFI contracts (financing, building and running costs) compared with traditional NHS funded hospitals?
- 3. What is the government's estimate of the costs of the NHS market in England?
- 4. Doctors warn of serious patient safety risks from the Physician Associate role in the NHS, with a recent <u>BMA survey suggesting some 87% of Doctors</u> find the current practice of Physician Associates to be a danger to patients, prompting legal action against the GMC from Anaesthetists United. With this in mind, can we move towards a pause on the recruitment of new PAs and a reassessment of the role? And whether plans exist for a national scope of practice for current PAs?
- 5. What measures has and will the government take to hold the government of Israel to account for the collective punishment of Palestinians and the targeting of health workers.
- 6. What measures is the government taking to respond to public concern about the use Palantir to provide a data platform for the NHS given its record in Palestine and around the world.
- 7. EDM This house notes the failure of previous PFI schemes and agrees to oppose PFI or versions of such schemes to fund NHS infrastructure.
